TWO RIVER THEATER LAUNCHES "INSIDE TWO RIVER," A NEW SERIES OF FREE EVENTS, WITH A SPECIAL SCREENING OF THE LANDMARK FILM CABARET, STARRING JOEL GREY

Screening will be presented on Tuesday, September 24 at 7pm in Red Bank's Riverside Gardens Park in partnership with Shore Flicks

RED BANK, NJ — Two River Theater, under the leadership of Artistic Director John Dias and Managing Director Michael Hurst, will present a free screening of the 1972 film *Cabaret*, directed by Bob Fosse and starring Liza Minnelli, Michael York, and Joel Grey, to kick-off a new series of free event called 'Inside Two River.'

The screening—on Tuesday, September 24 at 7pm in Red Bank's Riverside Garden's Park—is offered in connection with Paul Osborn's play *On Borrowed Time*, which Grey is directing as the opening production of Two River's 20th Anniversary Season. (*In the event of rain, the screening will be moved to the Bow Tie Cinema on White Street*.) "Inside Two River" is a new series of free events—including open rehearsals, film screenings, literary chats, panel discussions, and more—curated for each of Two River's productions throughout the season.

Grey originated the role of *Cabaret's* Emcee on Broadway and is one of only nine actors to have won both the Tony and Academy Award for the same role. He also received the Golden Globe and British Academy Award for his performance in the film version. He made his theatrical debut at the age of nine in a 1941 Cleveland Play House production of *On Borrowed Time*, a magical fantasy about the love between a little boy and his grandfather, who outwit Death and trap him in an apple tree.

Performances of *On Borrowed Time* begin on Saturday, September 14 and continue through Sunday, October 13. The opening night is Friday, September 20 at 8pm. Tickets are available from 732.345.1400 or tworivertheater.org. The lead production sponsor is Ann and Thomas Unterberg and the co-sponsors are Brookdale Community College and ZAIS Group, LLC.

Shore Flicks is New Jersey's original source for outdoor movie fun, serving Monmouth and Ocean Counties and all of New Jersey. Each summer they host the Free Summer Movie Series at local parks with a 40' screen and high-end projection and sound system.
