Commissioned by Two River last season, *A Wind in the Willows Christmas* is written by composer Mike Reid, lyricist Sarah Schlesinger, and bookwriter Mindi Dickstein. Following its 2012 premiere production—which *Talkin' Broadway* called "sunny, funny and unusually sophisticated family entertainment"—the musical is being further developed this season and will return to the theater as a newly conceived wintry wonderland directed by Daniella Topol. *A Wind in the Willows Christmas* will run December 7-29 and is recommended for audiences aged 5 and older.
